The group recited the pledge of allegiance.

Motion by Baker, seconded by Lyon approving the consent agenda consisting of the agenda, May 21st regular minutes and May 29th special minutes, bills, renewal of cigarette permits filed by B&C Liquor, Can City, Casey's 2846, Casey's 2578, Dollar General 2205, KJ's Convenience, Kwik Star 0212, Kwik Star 0894, Fareway Stores 639, Perxactly's and Walmart, event application including noise variance filed by Karen Wells for Relay for Life, and event application filed by Erica Barker and The Maquoketa Chamber of Commerce for Timber City Adventure Race. Motion by Lyon, seconded by Kuhlman approving Resolution No. 2018-22, entitled, 'Resolution Appointing Erica Barker To Fill The Vacancy Of 3rd Ward Council Person Created By The Resignation Of Council Member Josh Smith.'" Motion Carried 4-0
