

MAQUOKETA CITY COUNCIL MEETING
Monday, October 15, 2018

Mayor Schwenker called the regular session of the Maquoketa City Council to order at 7:00 p.m. with six members present.

Present: Kean, Baker, Lyon, Collister, Kuhlman, Barker

The group recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Kuhlman, seconded by Collister approving the Consent agenda consisting of the agenda, October 1st regular minutes and special minutes, bills, monthly financial reports for August and September, renewal of Class "B" beer permit and Sunday sales filed by Happy Joe's Pizza, and tree trimmer renewal filed by Dale Delarm. Motion Carried 6-0

Randy Johnson introduced himself in the audience asking for help from the City with fixing the football field after all of the rain. He also stated that he would be going to Indianapolis from November 14th to the 17th to represent the City with the Drum Corp.

Mayor Schwenker reminded the Council that they had two applications from Ron Horan and Dan Holm to fill the vacancy of 1st Ward Council Person.

Motion by Collister, seconded by Lyon approving Resolution No. 2018-39 entitled, "Resolution Appointing Ron Horan To Fill The Vacancy Of 1st Ward Council Person Created By The Resignation Of Council Member Craig Orris". Motion Carried 6-0

Motion by Collister, seconded by Lyon to approve the second reading of Ordinance No. 1145 – An Ordinance amending Chapter 4 – fire protection – of the code of ordinance of the City Of Maquoketa, Iowa. Motion Carried 6-0

Discussion was held concerning the purchase of a fire truck.

Kuhlman questioned whether the money for the truck was coming from the City's CIP or was being paid for completely by the fire department.

Craig Muhlhausen stated that the money would be coming from the CIP.

Motion by Collister, seconded by Lyon authorizing the purchase of a fire truck form Toyne in the amount of \$241,012.84 after a \$4,167.00 discount. Motion Carried 6-0

Motion by Collister, seconded by Lyon approving Resolution No. 2018-40 entitled, "Resolution Accepting The Bank Alley Improvement Project As Complete And Authorizing Payment Of Retainage To Dave Schmitt Construction In The amount Of \$10,339.65 On November 14, 2018. Motion Carried 6-0

Motion by Collister, seconded by Kean authorizing payment of retainage in the amount of \$15, 284.48 to River City Paving for 2018 street repairs. Motion Carried 6-0

Discussion was held on the wellness floor at the YMCA. Scott Warren stated that the grant that would be applied for would match funds to fix damage and resurface the wellness floor.

Motion by Lyon, seconded by Kuhlman authorizing application for State Of Iowa Rural YMCS Grant with match up to \$17,872.00 for wellness floor at YMCA. Motion Carried 6-0

Barker and Kean reminded everyone that about Maqtober Fest this weekend. It starts at 11:00 a.m. with a 1:00 p.m. dedication of the art piece on the green space.

Motion by Barker, seconded by Kuhlman adjourning at 7:11 p.m. All Ayes
