4-4-1 DEFINITIONS For use in this Chapter, the following terms are defined:

- A. "Apiary" shall mean a place where bees are kept.
- B. "Constructed Hive" shall mean an enclosure made of wood or metal used to house bees for honey production.

4-4-2 BEEKEEPING PERMITTED

- A. One apiary shall be allowed per parcel in areas zoned A-1 Agricultural or I-3 Heavy Industrial
- B. Each apiary must consist of only 1 constructed hive.

4-4-3 LIABILITY

The City shall not be liable for any damages, injury or death caused by bees under this ordinance.

4-4-4 NUISANCES

Any violation of the terms of this chapter that constitutes a health hazard or that interferes with the use or enjoyment of neighboring property is a nuisance and in addition to any other remedy provided by law, may be abated under Title 3 Chapter 2 of this code.

Section 2. REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinances as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
